SEE A NEW LINE OF COLORFUL TABLES FOR SPRING

The Palais table by 22 22 Edition Design comes in eight colors.

To complement spring's plentiful pastel hues, a new outdoor table range from the Parisian company 22 22 Edition Design offers a colorful, modernist meeting point for terraces and gardens alike. Made in France from laser-cut steel, then coated with epoxy paint and a durable protective layer, the 22 22 Palais table line was introduced at Maison & Objet in Paris this past January and is now for sale in eight shades, ranging from Yves Klein blue to baby pink.

The spherical base consists of a series of ribbonlike metal strips forming a symmetrical, hollow tube that meets the solid, round table top, which features a decorative cutout pattern around the perimeter. The table is the latest addition to the 22 22 Palais collection, which includes a chair, an armchair, and a three-seat bench, all intended for outdoor use but equally at home indoors.

"The inspiration for this collection came to me as I was observing a sculpture-object made of distorting mirrors that reflected off one another during the Dynamo exhibition in Paris in June 2013," says designer Jean-Claude Cardiet, cofounder of 22 22 Edition Design. "I immediately realized that this 90-degree pattern could be the starting point of an outdoor furniture collection that is both flexible and rigid, antique yet contemporary, graphic and iconic."
